Ice & Snow, Take It Slow!

- *Drive for conditions - slower speeds, slower acceleration, slower steering, and slower braking.
- *Use your headlights.
- *Do not use cruise control.
- *Four-wheel and all-wheel vehicles do not stop or steer better on ice than two-wheel drive vehicles.
- *Leave extra room between your vehicle and the vehicle in front of you. Remember; the larger the vehicle, the longer the stopping distance.
- *Slow down when approaching intersections, offramps, overpasses, & bridges.
- *If you find yourself behind a snow-plow, stay behind it until it is safe to pass.
- *Keep a basic winter survival kit in your vehicle: flashlight, batteries, blanket, snacks, water, gloves, boots, & first-aid kit.

Stay Healthy This Winter

Wash your hands and use hand sanitizer frequently! The flu virus tends to spread from October to May, with most cases occurring in January or February. Vaccinations can be given at any time during the flu season - even getting a vaccination later in the season (December through March) can still help protect you from influenza.

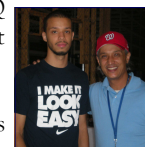


Driver Appreciation Day

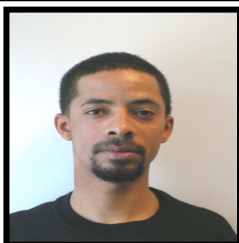
Breast Cancer Awareness Potluck
